What Nominet has done

1	Increase public benefit donations	✓ DONE	Public Benefit is doubling this year, then 10% of revenues. Plus £25M of reserves earmarked for public benefit programme.
2	Reduce .UK prices	✓ ADDRESSED	We've frozen .UK prices for the next 2 years. We're now 40% below .com prices.
3	Reduce director remuneration	✓ UNDERWAY	We've frozen board and executive pay for the next 2 years.
4	Reduce diversification	🗨️ FURTHER DIALOGUE	We focus on DNS cyber security tools that protects the .UK namespace and governments.
5	Improve communication with members	✓ ADDRESSED	We are setting up a Registry Advisory Council – the 'Design Group' was launched 9 March.
6	Adopt the UK corporate governance code	✓ DONE	Already compliant to best practice codes for companies of our size. Now increased financial disclosures.
7	Ensure Nominet remains independent and financially strong	✓ DONE	We have a strong balance sheet with future growth opportunities. EGM risks government intervention.
