




Geographical distribution of complainants & respondents in 2014

In 2014 the DRS saw cases bought by complainants from 35 different countries, with respondents from 51 countries.





Case outcomes

In the event of deadlock, complainants can pay to appoint independent experts from a panel to make a full or summary decision.
